

What is Title I?

Austin Road Middle is identified as a Title I school as part of the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). Title I is designed to support state and local school reform efforts tied to challenging state academic standards in order to reinforce and enhance efforts to improve teaching and learning for scholars. Title I programs must be based on effective means of improving scholar achievement and include strategies to support parental involvement. All Title I schools must jointly develop with all parents and family members a written parent and family engagement plan.



School Plan for Shared Scholar Achievement

What is it?

This is a plan that describes how Austin Road Middle School (ARMS) will provide opportunities to improve parent engagement to support scholar learning. In an effort to bridge the gap between our parents and the school, ARMS places a significant amount of emphasis on providing parent support, while encouraging consistent involvement



in their child's academic and extracurricular endeavors. All stakeholder activities and events are designed to promote and increase scholar achievement while strengthening and improving our overall school as a community of life long learners.

How is it revised?

Austin Road Middle School conducted a Title I Parent Input Meeting in the spring of 2023 and fall of 2023. During these meetings, parents and family members had the opportunity to revise and review this parent and family engagement plan, the school-parent compact, the school-wide plan and the family engagement budget. Parents also provided ideas on building school staff capacity. Feedback from parent input surveys & evaluations are solicited during the school year regarding this plan. ARMS welcomes and strongly encourages parent input and feedback throughout the school year. Feedback is also encouraged at every parent and family engagement meeting and activity. Any unsatisfactory comments by parents about the schoolwide plan will be shared with the District.

Who is it for?

All scholars of ARMS benefit from the Title I, Part A program, and their families are encouraged to fully participate in the opportunities outlined in this plan. Austin Road Middle School will provide full opportunity for the participation of parents and family members with limited English, parents with disabilities and parents of migratory children.

Where is it available?

The 2023-2024 plan will be distributed to parents following the Annual Title I Meeting before November 1, 2023. It will be posted on the school's website (www.henry.k12.ga.us/arm). Austin Road Middle School will increase the percentage of students in grade 8 reading on or above grade level from 60% to 65% as measured by the 2024 Spring MAP Assessment.

Austin Road Middle School will increase the percentage of students in Algebra 1 scoring proficient and above on the 2024 Georgia Milestones Assessment from 45.83% (based on 2022 – 2023) to 50%.

Goal 3

Austin Road Middle School will increase the percentage of parental and community engagement opportunities by 50%

- * Maintain a Family Resource Center for parents and guardians to access technology, materials, other resources and information for both personal and scholar academic support.
