You are invited and encouraged to take part in the selection of your son's/daughter's courses for the 2012-13 school year. A parent meeting will be held for each grade level according to the [schedule on the back of this letter](#). At the meetings, grade-specific information will be shared. A separate AP/Honors meeting has also been scheduled for those who are interested in enrolling in advanced level courses. At grade level meetings, parents will make an after school appointment to finalize the registration process with the assistance of advisors and counselors. (Please note: Students receiving special education services will register through their spring IEP meeting and will not need an appointment.)

Prior to the meetings and appointments, counselors will visit classrooms to give information and answer questions. It is advised that parents and students review course descriptions from the High School Advisement Guide which is available at www.henry.k12.ga.us. All courses are YEAR-LONG.

Please note that the courses listed below require the completion of an application or an audition prior to registration. On Friday, January 20, applications for these courses will be available in the Counseling Office and must be returned to the instructors by Tuesday, January 24, 2012. Auditions must also be completed by Tuesday, January 24, 2012.
