



Hampton Elementary School

As part of the school-wide discipline plan for HES, students in K-5 are eligible to participate in the HES quarterly HORNET FEST event. Criteria to be invited to the event involve students earning "Hornets" for extraordinary behavior and performance. Examples of such behavior may include helping a classmate who has dropped his or her books, holding the door open for one's teacher, meeting the reading goal for the week, or mastering the multiplication facts. Students must earn 35-50 Hornets within a 12-week time frame. At the end of the time period students who have earned enough Hornets will be invited to HORNET FEST in which students will be treated to activities such as magic shows, inflatables, and cookouts with the principals, carnivals, and much more.

This type of behavioral plan focuses on efforts in positive behaviors when students do well, rather than the negative misbehaviors. By reinforcing the desired positive behaviors we hope to significantly reduce the number of negative, undesired behaviors at HES.

Individual Student Goal:

Any staff member (including bus drivers) may award Hornets to students for outstanding behavior. Teacher will assist students in keeping track of their Hornets in their classrooms. Each office referral a student receives will result in the loss of 5 Hornets. Bus referrals will result in 2 Hornets being subtracted for the student's total. Teachers may not take away Hornets. Only administrators may take away Hornets from students.
