# Stockbridge High School

Dear Families of 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, and 11<sup>th</sup> Grade Students:

Registration for the 2012-2013 school year is about to begin! Together with their families, students will make important decisions about future career and educational goals. We invite and encourage families to become actively involved with the registration process.

Below you will find the step-by-step plan we will follow to register students, along with suggestions for how you can become involved at each step:

## STEP 1

All Students

**Friday, January 27**

Teachers make course recommendations for the 2012-2013 school year. Students keep a copy and turn in the original Course Recommendation Form to the 7<sup>th</sup> period teacher at the end of the day.  
**Family involvement:** Please review the course recommendations with the student. Parents of 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> graders should bring the form to the Parent Registration Meeting.

## STEP 2

11<sup>th</sup> Grade Students

11<sup>th</sup> Grade (rising seniors) Parent Registration Meeting and AP and Honors Meeting, 6:00-7:30 p.m. Stockbridge High School Commons Area

**Monday, February 13**

10<sup>th</sup> Grade (rising juniors) and 9<sup>th</sup> grade (rising sophomores) Parent Registration Meeting and AP and Honors Meeting, 6:00-7:30 p.m. Stockbridge High School Commons Area

**Family involvement grades 9 - 11:** Families attend and receive information about the registration process, including requirements for graduation. Information about AP and Honors courses will be presented at this meeting. Families may meet representative teachers from different subject areas. Parents of rising seniors (current 11<sup>th</sup> graders) may schedule a registration appointment with a counselor. **Attendance at this meeting is required for any 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, or 11<sup>th</sup> grade student considering enrolling in an AP and/or Honors course for the 2012-2013 school year.**

**\*\*\*AP/Honors Consent Forms must be signed and returned to the Counseling Office no later than March 30, 2012, at 3:30 p.m.\*\*\***

**STEP 3**

**11<sup>th</sup> Grade Students  
(rising seniors)**

**Advisement/Registration**

**February 1 and 2: 11<sup>th</sup> Grade students (rising seniors)** and their parents register during individual appointments with a counselor.

**Family involvement:** Parents are encouraged to attend this registration appointment. Parents sign the registration form that is returned to the Counseling Office.

**10<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> Grade  
Students (rising juniors  
and sophomores)**

**February 29 and March 1: 10<sup>th</sup> Grade (rising juniors) Registration**  
Small group advisement sessions for 10<sup>th</sup> grade students to discuss career and educational goals for 2012-2013 with counselor.

**March 27 and 28: 9<sup>th</sup> Grade (rising sophomores) Registration**  
Small group advisement sessions for 9<sup>th</sup> grade students to discuss career and educational goals for 2012-2013 with counselor.

**Family involvement:** Parents sign the registration form and students return it to the Counseling Office. Please contact the counselor, or attach a note to the form, stating any questions or concerns.


**LAST DAY TO REQUEST CLASS CHANGES FOR 2012-2013


