Quick Start Guide

1. Go to www.firstinmath.com
2. Type User ID/Password (ID begins with 2 numbers, ends with 2 letters)
3. Click GO, then click GO on the Progress page
4. You are now on your Player Home Page—click a Skill Set[®] Game, GYM or Bonus Game to begin!

Parents: Log on as a VISITOR and browse the Parents section.

Note: Please make sure Adobe Flash 7 or greater is installed.

Your child has been given a First in Math[®] User ID and password. If you choose to access the site at home, your child will need a computer with internet access and Flash Player software (free download). The ID numbers and passwords have been assigned by the company. The system will also only allow for 6 letters to be entered for each child's name. For example, Meredith will look like Meredi in the system. If you do happen to lose the card, please feel free to contact your child's homeroom teacher.

We ask that you take an active role in supporting your child's education - encourage your child to play a few minutes each day to greatly increase their math skills, as well as their overall academic confidence and performance.
