

## **NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE**

The Henry County Board of Education has tentatively adopted a millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes by 6.50% over the rollback rate.

This tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 20.00 mills, an increase of 1.221 mills. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than 18.779. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of \$225,000 is approximately: \$105.01 and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of \$300,000 is approximately \$146.52
