

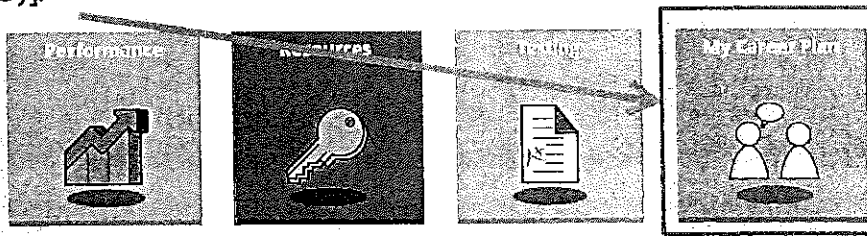
GCIS and the BRIDGE Law

7th Grade Students: Interest Profiler (60 Questions)

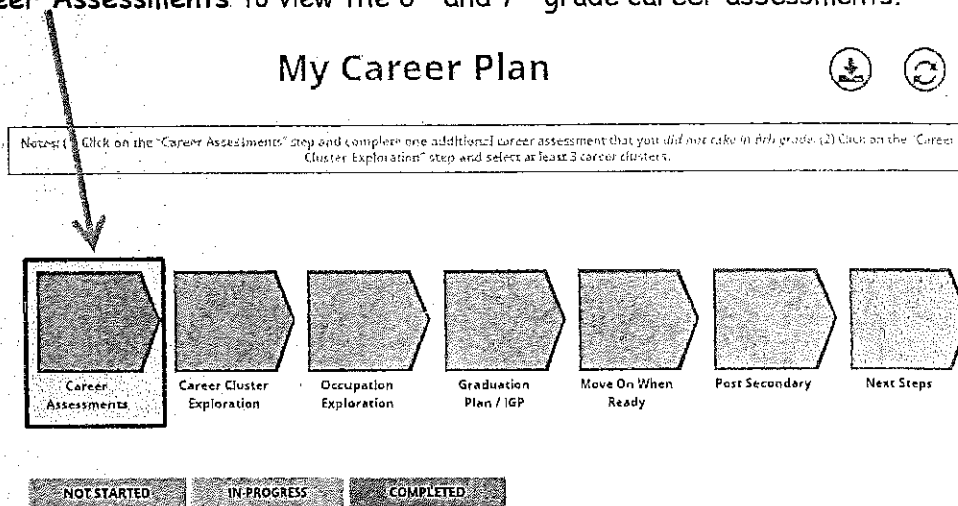

How Do I Complete My BRIDGE Law Activity in GCIS?

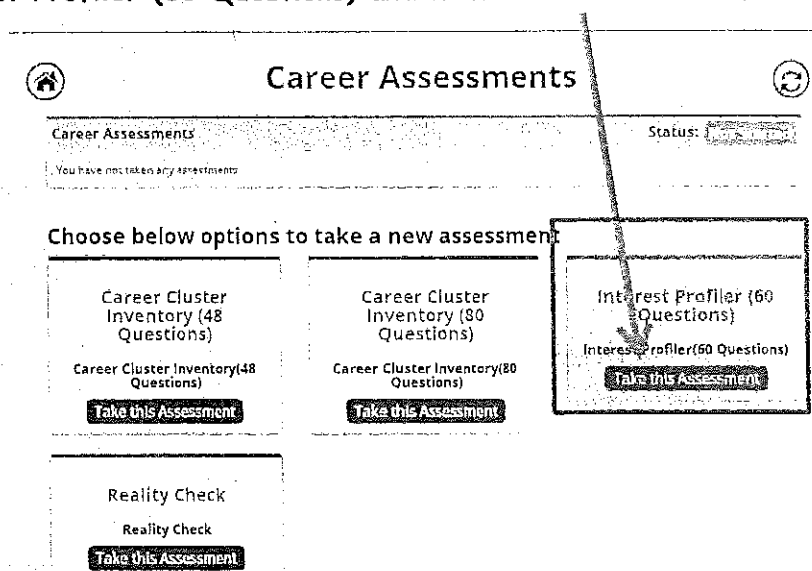
1. Log into your personal student portal provided by your school district.
2. Click on **SLDS Portal** on your dashboard. (The link name may vary depending on your SIS.)
3. Click the **My Career Plan** image. [This button will take you to the Georgia Career Information System (GCIS)].



4. Click **Career Assessments** to view the 6th and 7th grade career assessments.



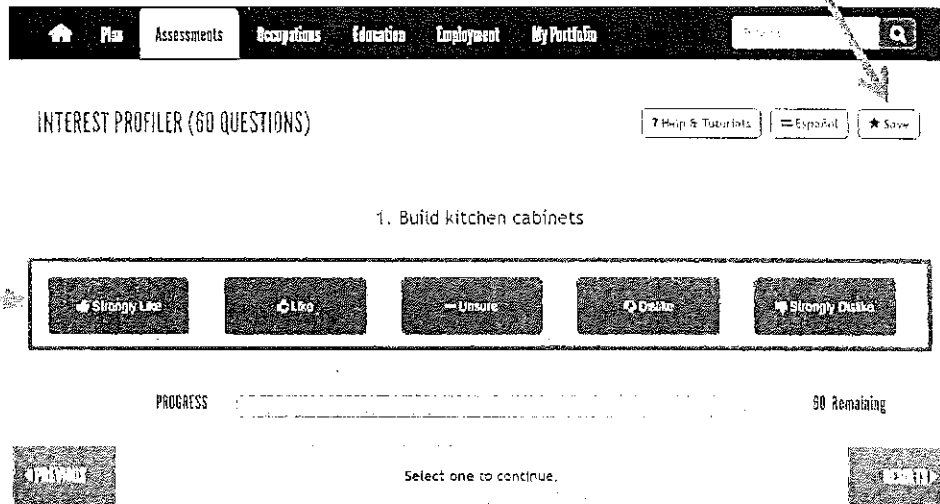
5. Locate **Interest Profiler (60 Questions)** and click **Take this Assessment**.



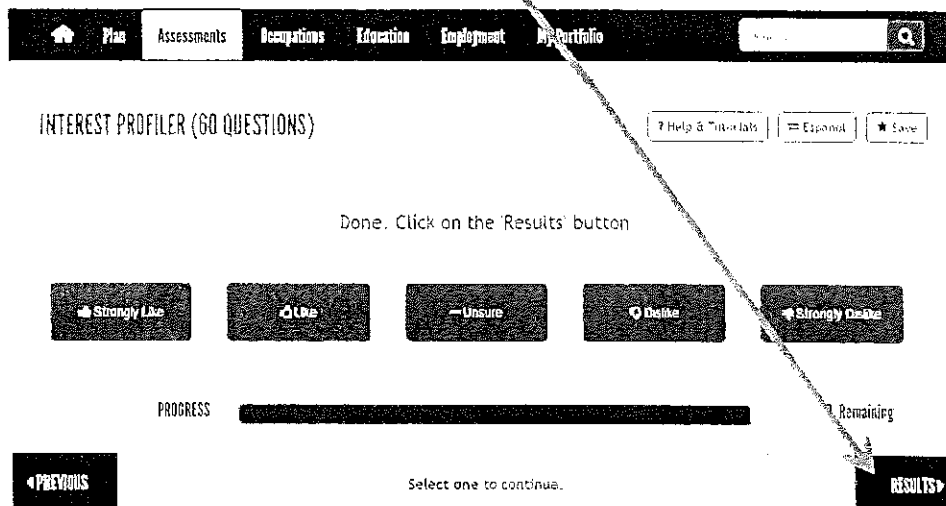
6. Read the instructions, and click **Rate the Activities**.



7. Make your selection on each screen. The page automatically advances to the next item. (NOTE: If you need to log off before rating all the activities, be sure to click **Save** to store your answers.)



8. After you make your last selection, click **Results**.



9. You will see your Interest Profiler (60 Questions) scores displayed from highest to lowest. You can click the six Interest Areas to see a list of occupations that match each interest. Click **Save**.

INTEREST PROFILER (60 QUESTIONS)

Using Your Interests to Explore Occupations

Your Score: 35

Investigative

People with investigative interests like work activities that have to do with ideas and thinking more than with physical activity. They like to search for facts and figure out problems mentally rather than to persuade or lead people.

Your Score: 28

Social

People with social interests like work activities that assist others and promote learning and personal development. They prefer to communicate more than to work with objects, machines, or data. They like to teach, to give advice, to help, or otherwise be of service to people.

Your Score: 25

Enterprising

People with enterprising interests like work activities that have to do with starting up and carrying out projects, especially business ventures. They like persuading and leading people and making decisions. They like taking risks for profit. These people prefer action rather than thought.

Your Score: 24

Artistic

People with artistic interests like work activities that deal with the artistic side of things, such as forms, designs, and patterns. They like self-expression in their work. They prefer settings where work can be done without following a clear set of rules.

Your Score: 22

Realistic

People with realistic interests like work activities that include practical, hands-on problems and solutions. They enjoy dealing with plants, animals, and real-world materials, like wood, tools, and machinery. They enjoy outdoor work. Often people with realistic interests do not like occupations that involve a lot of paperwork or working closely with others.

Your Score: 20

Conventional

People with conventional interests like work activities that follow set procedures and routines. They prefer working with data and detail over their with ideas. They prefer work in which there are precise standards rather than work in which you have to judge things by your self. These people like working where the lines of authority are clear.
