5. Principal’s Agenda

- Return to Campus/COVID-19 Update

Mr. Shedd discussed the return to school, including a brief overview of the entry to Phase 2. Phase 4 will start Monday, 10/26. Ola High School, with about 60% of students electing face-to-face instruction, will remain on a block schedule to limit the number of transitions and allow for responsible distancing over five lunch periods.

There was discussion about the challenges that teachers face. Mr. Shedd applauded teachers for the balance they show in addressing the needs of both in-person and virtual student groups. He also recognized that teaching both groups simultaneously is not sustainable for the long-term.

- FTE (School funding)

Mr. Shedd presented the FTE data.

Grade data is comparable for face-to-face and virtual learners.

- Caution Cards – sent to families with students failing one or more classes at the end of the 9 weeks

Counselors and administrators will provide guidance for parents. Chadd Sheffield asked that the counselors also provide parents strategies to help support their struggling students.

- Transition Academy

This a tough group of students that need to complete credit recovery or remediate the Incomplete from spring semester.
