Curriculum News: What we're studying

ELA- Fiction – Central message of: Fables, folktales, poetry

Writing –Write opinion/persuasive texts in which students introduce a topic or book they are writing about, state an opinion, supply reasons that support the opinion, use linking words (e.g., because, and, also) to connect opinion and reasons, and provide a concluding statement or section.

Social Studies – Georgia's Past – Creek and Cherokee Tribes, Mary Musgrove, Tomochichi, James Oglethorpe

Math - adding up to four 2-digit numbers, reviewing time to the nearest 5 minutes & different ways to tell and write time.
