



School Year 2020-2021 Scholarship Offerings

For Georgia High School Seniors

- Up to \$5,000 for students pursuing college-based commercial flight training
- Up to \$3,000 for students pursuing other aviation sector college-based programs, i.e. Air Traffic Control, Airport Management, Aerospace Engineering, Corporate Flight Management, etc.
- Up to \$2,000, plus a \$1,000 tool credit with Snap-On Tools for students pursuing a college-based aircraft maintenance program

Scholarship Window closes March 1, 2021

Scholarship Requirements

1. Be a Georgia high school graduate and/or graduating with the class of 2021, or have a GED equivalent from an accredited Georgia school.
2. Be enrolled as a full-time student or be accepted as a full-time student into an accredited / FAA approved college program pursuing an aviation-related certificate or undergraduate or graduate degree in the fields of flight technology, aviation maintenance technology, aviation operations, aviation management, or aeronautical engineering (applicants in other aviation disciplines will be considered).
3. Have a cumulative GPA of 3.00 or better (college / high school, as applicable).
4. Submit a 500-1000 word essay, discussing how the GBAA Scholarship will impact the pursuit of your career goals.
5. Provide certified copies of High School and College (as applicable) transcripts.
6. Provide at least one Letter of Recommendation from a school official or advisor
