Hospital/Homebound Program

Informational Welcome Letter for Parents

Dear Parent:

The Hospital/Homebound Program allows a student with a medical condition to continue to receive a high-quality education during his/her period of infirmity. In order for application processing to take place in a timely manner, our office must have the “Parent Request for Hospital Homebound Services Form” as well and the “Medical Referral Form” to consider the application complete. Both forms are available via the Henry County Schools’ website: <https://schoolwires.henry.k12.ga.us/Page/122012>

Depending on the student’s needs, he/she may be approved for either **Full-Time HHB** or **Intermittent HHB**. Your child’s physician will make this recommendation.

If the student is approved for **Full-Time**, they will already have set hours for which HHB is approved. This form of HHB is most common when a student just had surgery and/or is immobile resulting in the student being unable to attend school.

However, if the student is **Intermittent**, there are no set hours. **The parent/guardian of the student is responsible for contacting the tutor to inform the tutor of the student’s consecutive (3-5 days) absences each week.** This form of HHB Services is most common when a student has a certain prolonged medical condition that may result in unplanned flare-ups causing the student to miss school.

Our goal is to ensure that eligible students receive high-quality, supplemental education while they are bound to the home or hospital. Please do not hesitate to contact us with any questions or concerns related to Henry County Schools’ Hospital Homebound Program.
