School Performance Goals

Goal 1: By the end of the 2020-2021 school year, 100% of students in 3rd through 5th grade will be reading on or above grade level improving from 67.3% in 2018 as measured by student Lexile scores derived from GA End-of-Grade Milestones. Short-term goals: By 2019, 80% of students will be reading on or above grade level, 90% by 2020, and 100% by 2021.

Goal 2: By the end of 2018-2019 school year, 50% of students, improving from 31%, in grades 3 through 5 will score Proficient Learner or above on the GA End-of-Grade Math Milestones.

Goal 3: In 2018-2019, 75% of teachers will utilize school-wide processes and practices for students to co-create their pathways and move within and across units at their own pace. 75% of students will upload evidence onto Learner Profile of co-authored unit playlists and reflection piece from each unit.
