<u>School Performance Goals</u>
<p>Goal 1: Stockbridge Middle School will decrease the number of behavior referral incidents amongst students in sixth through eighth grades from 561 to less than 530 by December and from 1,019 to less than 950 by May of 2019</p> <p>Goal 2: Stockbridge Middle School will increase the percentage of students in sixth through eighth grades scoring proficient or above on 2019 Georgia End-of-Grade Milestones assessment in Math to 30%, ELA to 40%, and in Science to 30%.</p> <p>Goal 3: Stockbridge Middle School will increase the percentage of all students meeting the grade-level Lexile target to 61%.</p>
