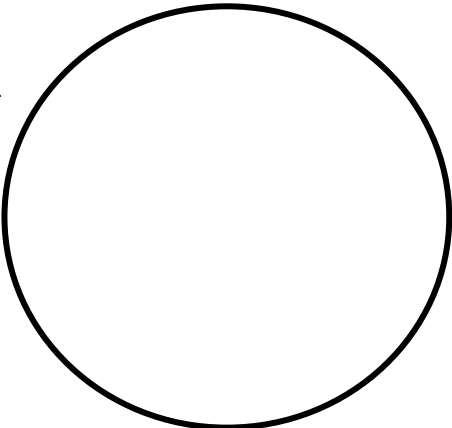
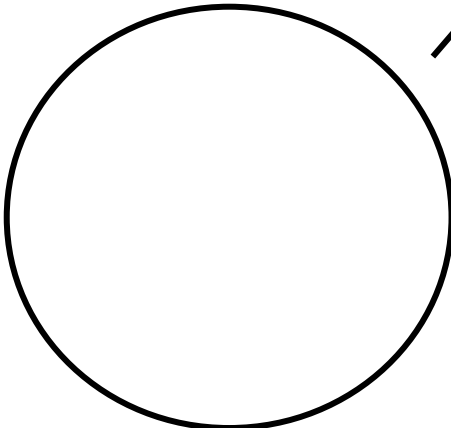
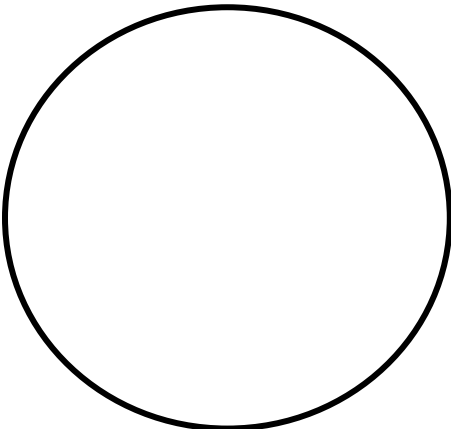
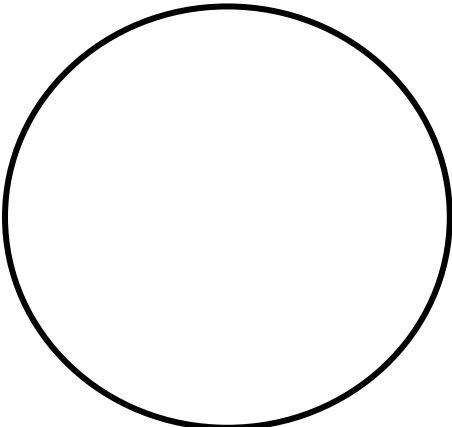
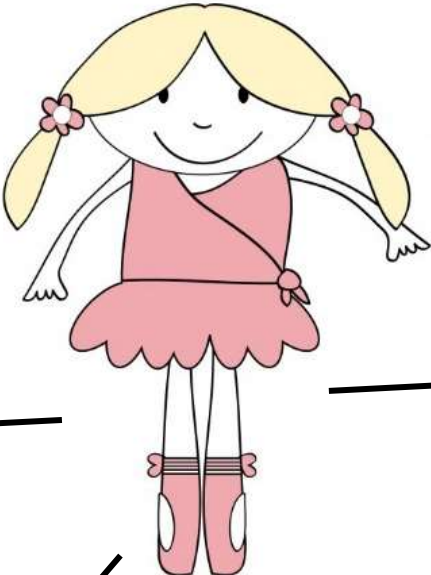
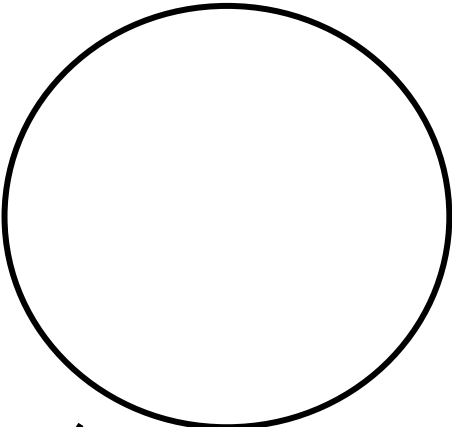
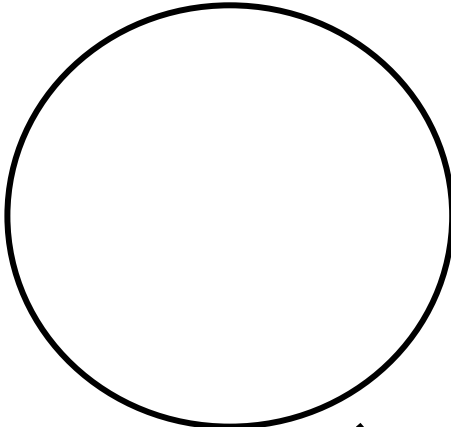
Phonics

Remediation (EIP): Watch The Short Vowel Song video to help you complete your phonics middle sound assignment.


