

Go fishing for pairs that make 10.



Your students probably already know how to play Go Fish, but in this version, they're fishing for pairs that add up to 10. Have them ask: "I have a 2. Do you have an 8 to make 10?" Change aces to 1 for this game and leave face cards out entirely.

Subtraction Top-It Players 2 Materials: Deck of cards, face cards worth ten, Ace worth 1 or 11. How to Play: Each player turns over two cards and subtracts the smaller digit from the larger digit. The player with the smallest difference wins all the cards. Continue until all the cards are gone. $7 - 2 = 5$ $9 - 5 = 4$ Player 2 wins all four cards. Make the game easier by taking higher digit cards out of the deck. Make the game harder by playing with 2- digit - 1-digit subtraction.
