## Phonics

Use the *b, c, n, r, t,* and *u* Letter Cards. Have them place all the cards in a row at the top of their desk or table. Say *cut*, and use it in a sentence. Say, "I *cut* the paper." Have students say the word. Ask students to say the first sound they hear in the word *cut*. /k/ Have them check the *Alphabet Sound Card* and tell which letters say /k/. *Cc* and *Kk* Point to *Alphabet Sound Card Cc*. Have students pull down Letter Card *c*. Ask students what sound they hear next in *cut*. /u/ Have them check the *Alphabet Sound Card* and tell which letter says /u/. *Short Uu* Point to *Alphabet Sound Card Short Uu*. Have students pull down Letter Card *u*. Ask students what sound they hear next in *cut*. /t/ Have them check the *Alphabet Sound Card* and tell which letter says /t/. *Tt* Point to *Alphabet Sound Card Tt*. Have students pull down Letter Card *t*. Have students blend the words *cut, nut, rut, run,* and *bun* using whole-word blending Letter Cards and Skill Sheet 176
