

Black History Bottle Buddy Project

DUE DATE: Monday March 15th

Please see the list posted in the Homeroom Google Classroom and on our webpage to find who you are assigned. I will assign each student the person they need to research and your project must be completed on the assigned person for credit.

Now the fun part...You will create a Bottle Buddy of your assigned person. Here is what you will need:

- 2 Liter Soda Bottle
 - a styrofoam ball (you can find this at Wal-Mart, Hobby Lobby, JoAnn's, Michael's)
 - paint, scissors, felt, markers, yarn, any other art supplies you'd like to use
 - an index card with the first and last name of your "buddy" BE CREATIVE!
- Have fun!!! Try your best to make your Bottle Buddy represent your person.

Bottle Buddy Checklist:

- None of the bottle is showing
- You have a mouth, nose, eyes and ears on your buddy
- Put something on the styrofoam ball (hair, hat, hood) to make it look like a person
- Use fabric scraps and/or material if possible (construction paper does not work well)
- Make sure your buddy more stable (so it won't tip), add sand or sugar to the bottom of the bottle before attaching the head
- Be sure to glue a head on
