<u><b>School Improvement Goals</b></u>		
<p>By the end of May 2020, increase the percent of students in grades 3 through 5 scoring proficient and above on the Georgia Milestones End-of-Grade Assessment in English Language Arts from 37.43 to 42 percent.          By the end of May 2020, students in Kindergarten through second grade will perform at 80% or above on the End of The Year Open Court Phonics Assessment.</p>		
<p>By the end of May 2020, increase the percentage of students in grades 3 through 5 scoring proficient and distinguished learners in mathematics from 43.08 percent to 48 percent on the Georgia Milestones End of Grade Assessment.          As a benchmark data measure in math, students in Kindergarten through second grade will score 80% or above on the end of year grade level common formative assessment.</p>		
<p>By the end of May 2020, increase the percentage of students in fifth grade scoring proficient and distinguished in Social Studies from 21 percent to 27 percent on the Georgia Milestones End of Grade Assessment.</p>
