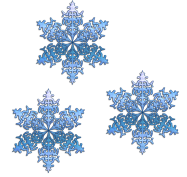

## Definitions

contradict (v)

to **speak** against; to **say** the opposite

dictation (n)

what is written down as someone **says** it

dictator (n)

a leader who **speaks** and rules with total power

diction (n)

the manner in which something is expressed in words  
(written or **spoken**)

dictionary (n)

a reference book in which **spoken** or written words are defined

dictum (n)

a judge's ruling or **statement**

edict (n)

public **words** issued by an official that explain a law or command

indictment (n)

formal words **spoken** or written by a jury that charge a person with a crime

predict (v)

to **say** what will happen before it occurs

verdict (n)

the decision a jury makes in a trial; the decision **said** by the jury
