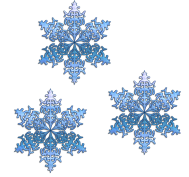

perspective (n)

respect (v)

to **look** up to someone; to show honor

retrospective (adj)

**looking** back at past things

spectacle (n)

something displayed for the public to **see**

spectacles (n)

glasses that help someone **see** better

spectator (n)

a person who **watches** something, such as a sporting event

speculate (v)
