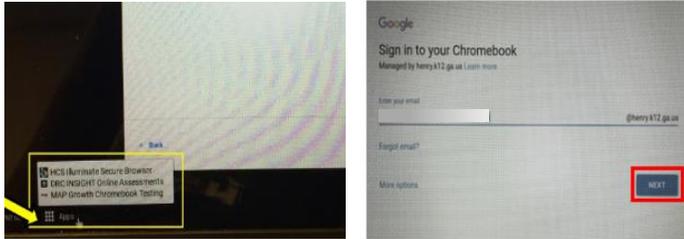


Chromebook: Sign in to your Chromebook



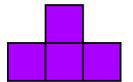
On the sign-in screen, Apps provides access to secured testing browsers for Illuminate, state milestones, and MAP Growth.

Obtain your child's username and password, from his/ her homeroom teacher. The username is also your child's HCS email address.

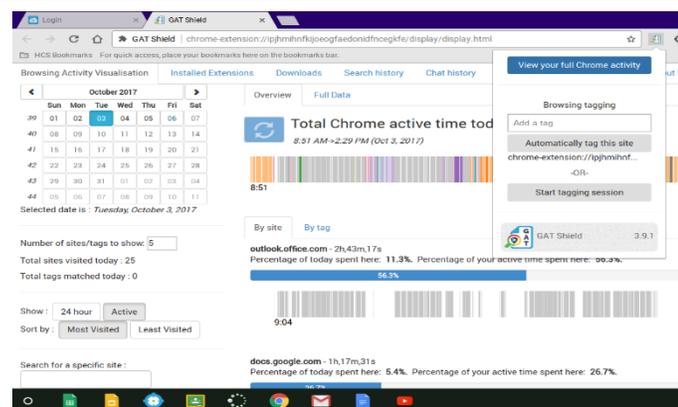
Only the Henry County issued username is able to log into the Chromebook device.



LanSchool is a classroom management tool that keeps students on task in a safe online environment. This screen allows students to **share their screen with the teacher while on the HCS Network**. This screen cannot be bypassed. If a student clicks anything other than Share, the LanSchool screen will continue to reappear until the student finally clicks share.

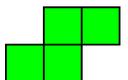


ClassLink is the Single Sign On solution for Henry County Schools. Log into Classlink to have one-click access to files, apps, and websites.



The Chrome browser includes district provided extensions for a safe online experience like GAT Shield which allows parents to view full Chrome activity by time and date.

The Chromebook taskbar includes the App Launcher and shortcuts to G Suite apps including Snap and Read and Google Classroom.

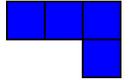


## Chromebook Shortcuts

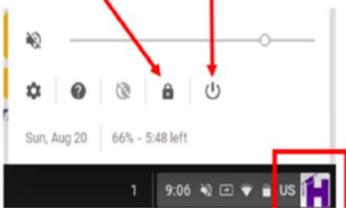

### DO's

- Bring to school fully charged.
- Safely store when not in use.
- Dust keyboard for crumbs and debris.
- Lock the laptop whenever you leave your machine unattended.

## INTRODUCING the CHROMEBOOK

### DON'T's

- Remove from the protective case.
- Place stickers or labels anywhere on the device.
- Eat or drink near your machine.
- Close the laptop with any foreign objects on the keyboard, i.e. pencil or pen.

- Use to fully charge device at home.
- Leave power cord at home each day.
- Attach a removable name label.
