Dear Parent/Guardian of Full-Time Remote Learners:

Spring 2021 End of Grade Georgia Milestones Assessment System testing window opens soon, and we are making final preparations for a successful testing season. Our testing window opens April 26, 2021, and closes on May 14, 2021. As we finalize our plans for testing, we wanted to share some information with you.

We also want you to be aware that Henry County Schools will again be testing face to face, as required by the GADOE, for the 2020 - 2021 school year. The detailed testing window is outlined below.

Critical information for testing this Year:

- The Georgia Milestones provides critical information for your child's teachers, school, and the school district related to your child's progress and performance. The Milestones assessment also provides families with important information related to your child's reading levels, growth in ELA and Math over previous years, and information on your child's mastery of content standards. The information helps all parties involved in your child's education be informed of the best way to help your student be successful on their educational journey, and helps to appropriately schedule your child for coursework for the coming year (advanced coursework and support opportunities).
- Full-time remote learners who wish to participate in the Milestones should contact the school principal to schedule a testing session.
 - Remote learners who come in to test may participate in the main test administration with their classroom, may participate in a small group during an afternoon test session, or may be scheduled to test on district-scheduled make-up days.
- **If you do not want your child to participate in the Milestones test due to COVID-related concerns, please notify your child's school of your desire to opt-out of testing due to COVID. Please follow the process outlined below.**
