### School Improvement Goals

**Student Performance Goal #1:** : Increase the percentage of students in grades three through five reading on or above grade level on the 2020 Georgia Milestones End-of-Grade Assessment in English Language Arts. Third graders will increase from 74% to 82%; Fourth graders will increase from 74% to 82%; fifth graders will increase from 76% to 85%.

**Student Performance Goal #2:** Grade level will increase their projected RIT growth, in math, on the NWEA Measures of Academic Progress from Fall to Spring. First grade will increase from 66% to 70%, second grade will increase from 22% to 50%, third grade will increase from 53% to 60%, fourth grade will increase from 35% to 50%, and fifth grade will increase from 39% to 50%.

**Student Performance Goal #3:** Dutchtown Elementary will increase the percentage of students in Grades K-2 reading on or above grade level by the end of this school year. 80% of Kindergarten students will read on grade level as measured by the Fountas & Pinnell spring assessment. First and Second grades will meet or exceed their projected RIT growth in Reading as measured by the MAP Assessment from fall to spring. First grade will increase from 56% to 66% and Second grade will increase from 38% to 50%.
