Below is a list of proposed CTAE courses to be offered at the Academy for Advanced Studies (AAS). The actual course offerings will be contingent on received student registrations. Bus transportation to AAS will be provided; however, students may provide their own transportation (a parking permit from the home school is required for students to receive a parking permit at AAS). **If a student is not selected for enrollment in the Academy for Advanced Studies, course selection will automatically default to the student’s original registration at the home school. Official registration must also be made online through IC. This form is due to the Counseling Office by March 21, 2014.**

AAS Daily Class Schedule

- A/B Block
- Even period classes meet Monday/Wednesday
- Odd period classes meet Tuesday/Thursday
- Friday’s courses alternate every other week

Transportation Option 1 – Students utilizing bus transportation

- Will be required to take a minimum of four (4) classes – two (2) on each day at AAS.
- Will take CTAE and/or dual enrollment courses and academic courses

Transportation Option 2 – Students utilizing own transportation

- Will be required to take a minimum of two classes – one (1) on each day at AAS
- Home school will have to accommodate their schedules and travel time.

AAS staff will work to accommodate all courses during both morning and afternoon sessions to meet student needs but final determinations will not be made until actual registration numbers are received. Please rank & initial by request(s).
