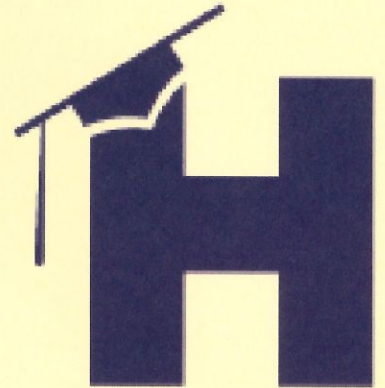


Proclamation
