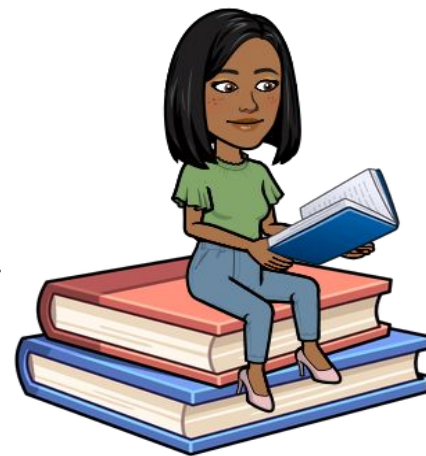
Remote Learning Expectations

- Students attendance is mandatory during each of their scheduled time slots.
- Students must enter the Google Meet on time and prepared for class.
- Student cameras must be on and visible at all times.
- Students should dress appropriately for class and are not permitted to be in bed during class.
- Participate in whole group and small group instruction.
- Headphones are encouraged to wear during class time.
- Work should be submitted to the designated area and turned in on time.
- Return all materials/resources back to ARE when school resumes.

Homework

- Students are expected to read 20 minutes each night in a book of their choosing and log it on the monthly Reading Log.
- Students are also expected to practice sight words for 10 minutes each day. A variety of fun ideas for practicing sight facts will be provided for your student to choose from.

Research has shown daily independent reading to be one of the most important factors in predicting student success in school. Please encourage your child to read daily, and ask questions about what he/she is reading!

Grading Policy
