Social Studies

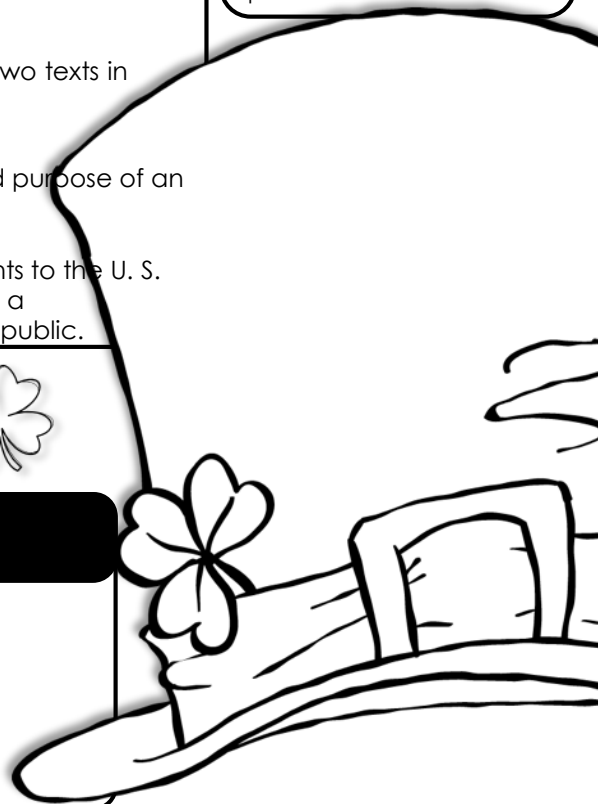
- I can explain how amendments to the U. S. Constitution have maintained a representative democracy/republic.
